As a participant in the WRC's referral program, students agree to attend their regularly scheduled appointment each week, to bring a writing-related activity to discuss with the tutor, and to practice independently between sessions. The referral typically runs from its initial assignment through the end of the semester, unless the tutor and student agree that the writing concerns the instructor has indicated on the form have been appropriately addressed. Also, the referral may end if the student: (a) misses two appointments without contacting the WRC in advance, (b) cancels three appointments, or (c) fails to participate actively in the sessions. Please note that students who lose referral status may visit the WRC offices on a walk-in basis only for the remainder of the semester.
